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## SECTION 01

# Northern Ontario Cottage Cleaning Challenges



Northern Ontario cottages face unique cleaning challenges driven by climate, wildlife, and seasonal vacancy.

Cottage cleaning in Northern Ontario is fundamentally different from urban residential cleaning. Extended vacancy periods, extreme seasonal temperature swings, wildlife intrusion, and hard water from lake or well sources create unique maintenance challenges that require a specialized approach.

## Key Northern Ontario Challenges

- **Seasonal vacancy:** Cottages left unoccupied for 6–8 months accumulate dust, moisture, and pest activity that requires systematic seasonal opening protocols.
- **Hard water and mineral deposits:** Lake water and well water in the Nipissing and Sudbury districts are typically high in calcium and iron. Faucets, toilets, and shower glass require regular descaling.
- **Wildlife intrusion:** Mice, squirrels, and insects enter through gaps in the building envelope during vacancy. Signs of intrusion must be identified and addressed before each opening.
- **Mold and mildew:** Cottages closed without adequate moisture control develop mold on walls, mattresses, and soft furnishings. Early identification during spring opening prevents costly remediation.

- Dock and waterfront maintenance: Algae growth on docks, boat ramps, and patio stones requires seasonal pressure washing.

## SECTION 02

# Spring Opening Clean



A thorough spring opening clean prepares the cottage for the season ahead.

The spring opening clean is the most comprehensive cleaning of the year. It addresses months of accumulated dust, any pest activity, moisture damage, and the residue left from fall closing preparations.

## Spring Opening Sequence

1

### Pest Inspection

Inspect for pest activity — droppings, nesting material, gnaw marks. Document and report before cleaning to preserve evidence for insurance if needed.

2

### Ventilate the Cottage

Open all windows and air the cottage for minimum 2 hours before cleaning.

3

### Mold Check

Check for mold — inspect bathrooms, closets, basements, and any areas prone to moisture. Address mold before general cleaning.

4

### Launder Soft Furnishings

Remove and launder all soft furnishings — mattress covers, pillowcases, throw blankets stored over winter.

5

**Full Interior Clean**

Clean interior top to bottom: ceilings, walls, light fixtures, windows, all surfaces, floors.

6

**Kitchen Deep Clean**

Kitchen deep clean — fridge power-on and clean, all drawers and cabinets wiped.

7

**Bathroom Descale**

Bathrooms — descale fixtures, clean behind toilet, scrub shower.

8

**Outdoor Furniture Reset**

Outdoor furniture — remove covers, wipe down, inspect for winter damage.

## SECTION 03

# Summer Maintenance Program

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Regular summer maintenance keeps the cottage guest-ready between visits.

Summer maintenance cleaning for rental cottages follows the same principles as Airbnb turnover cleaning — but adapted for the cottage environment, where guests often track in sand, lake water, and outdoor debris.

## Between-Guest Turnover Checklist

- Strip and launder all linens and towels
- Clean kitchen thoroughly — fridge check, all surfaces
- Deep clean bathrooms
- Vacuum and mop all floors — focus on sand and tracked-in debris
- Wipe all surfaces including lake-view windows
- Check BBQ and outdoor kitchen if applicable
- Clear dock and waterfront area of guest debris
- Restock toilet paper, paper towels, soap, garbage bags
- Inspect for damage — note any issues for owner
- Remove all garbage and recycling

## SECTION 04

# Fall Closing Clean



Proper fall closing prevents moisture damage, pest intrusion, and costly spring repairs.

The fall closing clean prepares the cottage for an extended vacancy during the Northern Ontario winter. Done properly, it dramatically reduces the scope of the spring opening clean and prevents damage.

## Fall Closing Cleaning Checklist

- ▣ Strip all beds — remove and store or launder all bedding
- ▣ Empty and clean the fridge — prop door open
- ▣ Empty all food from pantry and cabinets — sealed containers only if anything left
- ▣ Clean all kitchen surfaces, empty and dry the kettle, coffee maker, and small appliances
- ▣ Clean all bathrooms — drain all traps with propylene glycol if winterizing plumbing
- ▣ Seal all entry points visible to wildlife — gaps around pipes, vents, and foundation
- ▣ Set mouse traps and bait stations at key entry points
- ▣ Cover outdoor furniture and bring cushions inside or to storage
- ▣ Close and latch all windows and doors
- ▣ Document condition with photos for owner records

### Moisture Control

Leave a moisture absorber or desiccant pack in closets, under beds, and in bathrooms. This significantly reduces mold growth in the months of winter vacancy.

## SECTION 05

# Pest and Rodent Prevention



Pest prevention begins with cleanliness — removing food sources and sealing entry points.

Mice and squirrels are the most common cottage pests in Northern Ontario. They enter through gaps as small as 6mm — a dime's width — and can cause significant damage to wiring, insulation, and contents during a winter vacancy.

## Prevention Checklist

- ❑ Remove all food from the cottage — including cooking oils, spices, and pet food
- ❑ Empty all garbage and recycling before closing
- ❑ Inspect exterior for gaps around pipes, vents, and foundation — seal with steel wool and expanding foam
- ❑ Check dryer vent and range hood vent covers — rodents enter through both
- ❑ Set snap traps and/or bait stations at interior entry points
- ❑ Store linens and soft goods in sealed bins — mice nest in fabric
- ❑ Inspect propane lines and connectors — rodents gnaw through rubber fittings

### Signs of Intrusion

During spring opening, check for: droppings (black rice-sized pellets), gnaw marks on wood or plastic, nesting material (shredded insulation or fabric), and urine stains on stored items. Document and report before cleaning if intrusion is found.

## SECTION 06

# Water Systems & Plumbing Care



Water system maintenance is a seasonal priority for Northern Ontario cottage owners.

Lake-fed and well-fed water systems in Northern Ontario cottages require seasonal attention beyond standard cleaning. Hard water scale, filter maintenance, and freeze-prevention protocols are part of the cleaning service scope.

## Water System Cleaning Tasks

- ▣ Descale all faucets, showerheads, and toilet bases with citric acid or commercial descaler
- ▣ Clean water filter housing and replace cartridge as needed
- ▣ Inspect UV system lamp (if installed) — note age for owner
- ▣ Run and clean dishwasher with dishwasher cleaner tablet
- ▣ Descale kettle and coffee maker
- ▣ Check toilet tank for mineral buildup — clean with pumice or descaler
- ▣ After spring thaw — run water on all fixtures for 2–3 minutes before cleaning

### Iron Staining

Many Northern Ontario wells have elevated iron levels, causing orange or rust-coloured staining on toilets, tubs, and sinks. Commercial iron/rust removers (oxalic acid based) are effective. Standard bathroom cleaners will not remove iron staining.

## SECTION 07

# Outdoor Spaces & Waterfront



Decks, docks, and patio surfaces require seasonal pressure washing to remove algae and organic buildup.

Outdoor spaces are as important to the cottage experience as the interior — and in many cases, spend more time in a state of neglect. Algae, pine sap, bird droppings, and organic debris require dedicated outdoor cleaning.

## Outdoor Cleaning Checklist

- Deck — sweep, check boards for damage, pressure wash in spring
- Dock — sweep debris, pressure wash algae from walking surfaces
- Patio stones — pressure wash and treat for moss/algae if needed
- Outdoor furniture — wipe down all pieces, check for damage
- BBQ — clean grates, grease tray, and exterior
- Firewood storage — tidy area, ensure wood is dry and covered
- Garbage and recycling area — clean bins and pad
- Check exterior lighting — replace bulbs as needed

## SECTION 08

# Rental Turnover vs. Owner Use Cleans



Rental turnovers and owner use resets have different scopes and priorities.

Cottage cleaning scope varies depending on who was last in the property. Guest rental turnovers require full linen change, kitchen reset, and bathroom deep clean. Owner use resets are typically lighter — a tidy and refresh rather than a full service.

## Rental Turnover (Full Service)

- All linens changed and laundered
- Full kitchen clean including fridge check
- Full bathroom deep clean
- Vacuum and mop all floors
- Garbage and recycling removed
- All surfaces wiped
- Full restock of all consumables
- Damage inspection and documentation

## Owner Use Reset (Maintenance Clean)

- Linen change as needed
- Kitchen tidy and wipe
- Bathroom clean — not necessarily deep clean
- Vacuum and spot-mop
- Garbage removed
- Quick surface wipe

## SECTION 09

# Damage Identification During Cleaning

Professional cottage cleaners serve as the owner's eyes and ears. Identifying and reporting damage during cleaning — before the next guest arrives — is one of the most valuable services a trusted cleaning team provides.

## What to Document

- Breakage and damage: Broken fixtures, cracked tiles, damaged furniture, torn screens.
- Appliance issues: Fridge not holding temperature, oven element not working, toilet running.
- Water damage: Staining on ceilings, walls, or floors indicating leaks or seepage.
- Pest evidence: New droppings, gnaw marks, or nesting material since last visit.
- Unauthorized items left by guests: Items not included in the cottage inventory.
- Low stock items: Consumables that need restocking before next guest.

### Damage Documentation Protocol

Photograph all damage with a timestamp before cleaning the area. Send photos to the owner with a brief written description. This record is essential for security deposit claims on rental platforms.

## SECTION 10

# Building a Caretaker Relationship

The best cottage cleaning relationships evolve beyond a transactional service into a caretaker partnership. A trusted cleaning team that knows your property, your standards, and your guests is one of the most valuable relationships a seasonal property owner can have.
